The highly anticipated Capacity Restoration and Expansion Grants, as part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), are now open to proposals.

COVID-19 has had an extremely negative impact on capacity for all services in the intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) system. This funding will support projects in response to COVID-19's negative impact of on capacity for all services within the ODDS system.

Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS) is soliciting grant proposals from proposers in the following federally approved service category options.

- Start-up/rebuilding funding for employment day support activity providers;
- Start-up funding, training and technical assistance for culturally and linguistically specific providers for all services;
- Enhancing and growing all services for individuals with the highest support needs;
- Focused funding to expand capacity in rural areas; and
- Start-up funding for all other types of provider agencies.

Proposals must be submitted through <u>OregonBuys</u>, which is the state's eprocurement system. Please register at OregonBuys if you have not done so already. Once logged in, browse for open solicitations and find #S-10000-00004865to view the full Request for Grant Proposals.
