Re: New American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Project SEARCH grant available

The Office of Developmental Disabilities Services (ODDS) is seeking proposals for a new American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funded Request for Grant Proposals (RFGP). The Project SEARCH Grant Agreements for Transition-Age Programs funding opportunity is meant to support transitionage individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD). Specifically, it supports transition from school to getting competitive integrated employment. All details, requirements and qualifications are available in the solicitation.

Applicants must be either a community-based employment provider with status as a current Vocational Rehabilitation vendor; or a school district, career technical school, community college, or education service district who provides transition services.

A pre-proposal conference will be held on Wednesday, Dec. 21 at 10 a.m. More information about the project and RFGP process will be provided. This is also a great opportunity to ask questions about the project and process.
