The Office of Developmental Disabilities Services (ODDS) is pleased to share that a new American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Request for Grant Applications (RFGA) is now open. This funding is for educational institutions to pilot ODDS's Introduction to Supported Employment Curriculum. The goal is to help train current and prospective job coaches and employment providers to support people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD). ODDS is currently accepting applications from accredited community college institutions, accredited public or private colleges or universities, or public

school districts in Oregon.

Applications will be accepted continuously and evaluated in two openings. To be considered in the first round, applications must be received by 3 p.m. on March 11. Applications for the second round are due by 3 p.m. on April 12.
