Ready to fly?

Make sure to bring the right ID!



- As of May 2025, you will need federally acceptable identification to board a plane, even for domestic flights.
- Your standard Oregon driver license or ID card will not be acceptable for air travel as of May 2025.
- Consider getting the Real ID option when you renew your Oregon license.

Acceptable ID at airport security includes, but is not limited to:

 Oregon driver license or ID card with Real ID option.
