#### Top 10 Truck driver At Fault Errors:

- 1. Driving too fast for conditions
- Following to close
- 3. Fail to remain in lane
- 4. Fail to yield right of way
- 5. Improper turns
- Improper lane change
- 7. Inattention
- 8. Sleep/Fatigue
- 9. Disregard sign or signal
- 10. Improper backing

### Top Ten Car Driver at Fault (versus CMV) Errors:

- 1. Following too closely
- 2. Fail to remain in lane
- 3. Disregard signs
- 4. Driving too fast for conditions
- 5. Fail to yield right of way
- 6. Inattention
- 7. Improper passing
- 8. Improper turns
- 9. Sleep/Fatigue
- 10. DUII alcohol
