Specifies that flavoring of a prescription drug is not compounding.

Exempts from state income tax for a taxpayer who has not attained 63 years of age before the close of the taxable year for which a return is filed and is receiving retirement pay or pension for service in the Armed Forces of the United States up to \$17,500 in retirement pay or pension received for service in the Armed Forces of the United States.
