



## Eligibility & Admission Criteria

The Oregon Veterans' Home is a 151-bed Medicare and Medicaid-certified facility. To be admitted to the Home, an individual must be:

- ♦ A veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States as defined by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (USDVA) discharged under honorable conditions;
  - OR —
- ♦ A spouse, surviving spouse as defined by the USDVA;
  - OR —
- ♦ A parent, all of whose children died while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States;
  - AND —
- ♦ Be able to pay the resident's portion of the cost of care or be eligible for Medicaid;
- ♦ Be in need of nursing home care;
- ♦ Not require medical care for which the Home is not equipped or staffed to provide; and
- ♦ Not have traits which may be dangerous to the Home's residents, staff or others. However, this does not prevent the admission of applicants diagnosed with Alzheimer's Disease or similar illnesses for which the facility is equipped and prepared to provide care for common behavior problems and recommended behavioral management.

The nursing team is complimented by physical, occupational and speech therapists who provide specific physician-ordered services to help residents meet their maximum rehabilitative potential. The staff designs a personalized therapy program based on each individual's needs. Outpatient rehabilitation services also are available.



## Recreation Programs

The Home's recreation program offers numerous therapeutic benefits to residents through physical activity, creative expression and social involvement. These are essential keys to allow each resident to maintain a healthy, well-rounded lifestyle to the maximum extent possible - physically, mentally and socially.
