

# **Oregon Health Authority 2013 – 2015 Agency Request Budget**

## **Report on House Bill 4131 Compliance**

OHA's mission given to us by the Governor, the Legislature and agency leadership is that we must ensure the agency can support a health care system that is patient-centered, coordinated and reduces waste and inefficiency.

We are approaching this in a way that balances the intent of House Bill 4131, the intent of the changes to the health delivery system and how OHA can support these changes long term, including the implementation of our management system.

Regarding House Bill 4131, OHA has increased its supervisory to non-supervisory ratio by one as required by the legislation (from 7 to 1 to an 8 to 1 level) and the plan was submitted and approved by the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) on 7/25/12. By November 2013, it is OHA's intent to have reached the target of increasing our ratio by an additional 1 (9 to 1) as required.
