Note 1: percentages and rates in the "TOTAL" column may vary slightly from the full quarterly report because this set of data does not include the "other race" category.

Note 2: Ns represent the number of total people in each category who are eligible for a specific measure. For example, there were 46 non-Hispanic, Asian Americans who were eligible to receive follow-up care after a hospitalization for mental illness. (65.2% of them did receive it.) For the three measures that are reported by member months, Ns represent the total member months eligible for each measure; although N might equal, for example, 394,277, the rates for those measures are still reported per 100,000 member months.
