Congratulations! Our records show you successfully saved your benefits enrollments for the 2022-23 plan year. If you would like to review your enrollments or print your benefits statement, you can log back in to the MyOEBB enrollment system at OEBBenroll.com.

Please read the four important notes below:

1) Moda Medical Plans

Did you enroll in a Moda Health medical plan? If so, be sure to choose and use a PCP 360 to receive the enhanced coordinated care benefit. To do this, log into your Member Dashboard at modahealth.com/oebb. You can also call the Moda 360 Health Navigators at 866-923-0409 or send them an email at OEBBquestions@modahealth.com. If you already chose a PCP 360 for the 2021-22 plan year, you do NOT need to choose one again. Your current PCP 360 election will carry forward for 2022-23.

2) Dental Plans with Exclusive Networks

Did you enroll in one of these dental plans?

- Delta Dental Exclusive PPO Dental Plan,
- Delta Dental Exclusive PPO Incentive Dental Plan,
- Kaiser Permanente Dental Plan, or
- Willamette Dental Group Dental Plan

If so, you must use their specific limited network providers. There is no benefit if you use an out-of-network provider on these plans (except for emergencies).

3) OEBB/PEBB Double-Coverage – If you are a full-time active employee and you cover a dependent on your OEBB medical coverage who is also a full-time active employee and enrolled in their own OEBB or PEBB medical plan through their own employment,

you will pay a \$5 per month surcharge for this double-coverage. This surcharge is a state law that has been in effect since October 1, 2020.
