# Hot Topics

- First group of certified products released
  - Only 19 certified ambulatory EHRs initially
  - Several major products received modular certification when they should have received full certification
  - Several products have moved from modular to full certification in the last week
  - Many certified products not yet available
- Several eligibility issues remain unclear
  - Medicare Advantage
  - Electronic Dental Record Certification




# What Other Regional Extension Centers are Doing

Extension Center	Membership Milestone	Pricing
Washington / Idaho (WIREC) (QIO)	600	Free year 1, \$100/provider/month
South Florida (SFREC) (HCCN)	376	\$75/provider/month
Ohio (New Org)	14	\$100/provider/month
Chicago (HCCN)	366	\$1000/provider/year, \$250 per year
New York	830 (large installed base)	Free first 2 years (County Match) \$150/provider/month
O-HITEC (OCHIN)	275	\$100/provider/month
CalHIPSO	730	First year free for PPCPs, \$600/provider/year

# Criteria for Supported EHRs

- Leverage current investments in installed infrastructure to maximize economies of scale
- Encourage the purchase of hosted EHRs for ease of implementation, cost reductions, data aggregation and improve support
- Create significant market share for smallest number of products in each geographic area to reduce complexity for HIEs and HIOs
- Past and expected performance on certification
- Capable of supporting data aggregation plan for QCorp, OCHIN and the State's long term strategies
