

1	Overall Orpheus Updates – Stephen - No updates	
2	Electronic Case Reports (eCRs) – June - User might be seeing influenza or RSV reports in Orpheus because the State is working with OHSU in electronically reporting them; please ignore them. - Planned ELR Redesign will take about six months. We will be starting with the person search functionality.	Thank you to all users notifying Michelle of any ELR-related discrepancies.

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<p>3</p>	<p>E-mailing To Dos, a feature request – June</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- We've added a check box in the User Settings to allow the User to select the option of being notified by e-mail of an un-done To Do.- This feature is now live in Orpheus; so far no Orpheus User has checked this box  <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The notification won't happen in real time; it will be set for weekly e-mail notifications, beginning at the end of the day on Monday.- This is primarily designed for non-frequent Orpheus users.	<p>Users to let Michelle know the degree to which you would use this feature.</p>
	<p>Changes to transferring cases – June</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Because transferring cases continues to be problematic, State is proposing completely removing the Transfer Tab and to leverage the To Do tab for all transfers. No features would be lost. Everyone in the relevant county would see them. No dissenting opinions.	

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gerald mentioned that Benton County sometimes receives reports from Benton County, WA. The solution is to change the “County” to “Out of State” and the State to WA, and the State will route the report to Washington State. 	
<p>4</p>	<p>REAL-D check in – June</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Background information about REAL-D is on the Orpheus web page: https://www.oregon.gov/oha/PH/DISEASES/CONDITIONS/COMMUNICABLEDISEASE/REPORTING/COMMUNICABLEDISEASE/Pages/Orpheus.aspx - We’re keeping track of training video viewing metrics, but we have found that people have been watching it as a group, which is good news. - Remember, REAL-D data are derived from self reporting; however, the old race data are still available on the REAL-D screen – feel free to populate them with data from other sources, e.g., faxed report that includes race data. - Rachel most of the interviewed have no idea on how to distinguish the White race categories; the majority end up say “Other White.” We agree that it’s confusing. Best practice is that if you’re an America born person with a Slavic heritage and you want to be counted as a White person, then Other White should be checked. 	<p>June to send REAL-D survey</p>

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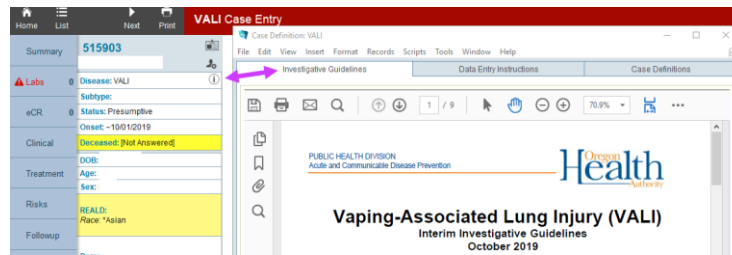
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Madeline (CSTE Fellow) is working on converting State’s Annual CD report to Tableau; monthly and weekly reports to follow. - Madeline has also about half way through the Campylobacter project. - State is also working with the State HST program, as well as with Taylor of Multnomah County. - GIS. We have connected to the secure, State ARC GIS Portal and are beginning development of GIS data; the plan is to visualize data at the census tract level. 	<p>Orpheus users to contact June if you’re interested in Orpheus visualization project, or if you have specific reports that you would like the visualization team to begin work on.</p> <p>GIS-related: Please send June any web sites you’d like us to emulate in terms of visualizing Orpheus data.</p>
<p>6</p>	<p>Vaping Associated Lung Injury (VALI) – Tasha</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HAN Alert recently went out describing the Governor’s executive order to make vaping reportable. - Tasha has created a VALI disease in a new Disease Module called “Emerging.” - Yesterday Stephen sent e-mails to all Overall Responsible Parties asking to designate VALI users; he’s heard back from 15 Counties so far. - The disease template is currently sparse for the time being. Labs and Risks are available; however, County Users are not expected to fill out the risks at this time. - We’ve boiled down the medical abstraction form from 50 pages down to 2 pages. - We’ll have a case report from available by next week, which we’ll build into Orpheus. 	<p>Orpheus users to review VALI investigative guidelines.</p> <p>State to provide visual dictionary of vaping products.</p>

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- Investigative Guidelines are available by clicking on the i button.



- If Providers report to Local Public Health, then please fill out the intake form, classify them as Suspect or Under Investigation in Orpheus.
- LPH will interview if case is Confirmed or Presumptive, which requires medical record review.
- State will coordinate production collection and testing
- If the physician reports to State, State will complete the intake form and review medical record.
- Question from Tasha – how does County want to be notified with regard to follow up on a presumptive report? Email or a To Do.
- State Case definition is following CDC’s case definition fairly closely; however, Oregon is only investigating hospitalized cases.
- CDC is accepting clinical specimens; State will coordinate with Oregon State Public Health Lab. N.B. CDC does not want just blood and urine; they also want the BAL specimen. OSPHL won’t forward blood and urine without BAL.
- Overarching message from Public Health is to refrain from vaping.

- 1) Vaped in last 90 days
- 2) Hospitalized overnight
- 3) Pulmonary infiltrates, such as opacities on plain chest radiograph or ground-glass opacities on chest CT

- Question: Are CBD Vapes included? Yes
- Question: What if the information comes from a hospital? The report is designed to fill out when a providers calls about a suspected VALI case.
- Tasha is currently the VALI point person here at the State.
