


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<p>3</p>	<p>E-mailing To Dos, a feature request – Michelle</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- We've received requests over the years for the ability for Orpheus to automatically e-mail a To Do.- We've added a check box in the User Settings to allow the User to select the option of being notified by e-mail of an un-done To Do.  <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The notification won't happen in real time; it will be set for weekly e-mail notifications, beginning at the end of the day on Monday.- This is primarily designed for non-frequent Orpheus users.-	<p>Users to let Michelle know the degree to which you would use this feature.</p>
<p>4</p>	<p>REAL-D check in – June</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Background information about REAL-D is on the Orpheus web page: https://www.oregon.gov/oha/PH/DISEASES/CONDITIONS/COMMUNICABLEDISEASE/REPORTINGCOMMUNICABLEDISEASE/Pages/Orpheus.aspx- About 30 users have taken the training. We combined the two training modules into one.	

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - It is optional, though many Counties had requested to have more granular race and ethnicity data. - Questions: If we get Language data from the Provider, which is what we use to determine whether we need an interpreter, instead of the Case Patient, which field do I use? State will un-hide the old Language field for use as a place holder. 	
<p>5</p>	<p>Orpheus Data Visualization Update – Michelle</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Oregon Public Health Division has launched a data visualization, which has given us access to Tableau. - Forming an internal team; June will plan to solicit LHD users re: visualization needs. Madeline (CSTE Fellow) will help build out visualizations. - We will begin with the Disease/Quarter/Month report. - GIS. We have connected to the State ARC GIS Portal and are beginning development of GIS data. - Question: what is the role of the local epi re: the pilot project? Feedback on priority of reports. 	<p>Orpheus users to contact June if you're interested in Orpheus visualization project, or if you have specific reports that you would like the visualization team to begin work on.</p> <p>GIS-related: Please send June any web sites you'd like us to emulate in terms of visualizing Orpheus data.</p>

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<p>6</p>	<p>Short Video Suggestions – June</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tom suggested that we use the new Skype video tool to update our videos, and many of our Orpheus training videos are outdated. - The idea is to create “Quick Tips” -- really brief, task-specific videos, e.g., how to add a pregnancy to a case. - Currently, we’re planning on making Quick Tip videos for: Duplicate Cases, Out-of-State cases, Perinatal Hep B cases, Deleting Cases, Running County Review Reports, Unprocessed vs Processed ELRs, Making notes, Sending To Dos, Querying Alert, Entering Vaccines, Contact Duper, Uploading a document, Interacting with CDC forms, the “i” icon, the “globe” icon, entering hepatitis serologies, case merging, managing line lists, etc. - The vision is to have a new video/week in short order. - Suggestions included: Tips for exporting data from Orpheus, exporting from Outbreaks database, transferring a case, creating a second case from an ELR. - Question from Brian: who is the point person for the contact duper?
