Clean garden ponds and stock with mosquito fish




OLD TIRES



Get rid of used tires properly

SWIMMING POOLS



Clean and maintain swimming pools

BIRDBATHS



Change water in birdbaths weekly

Take the bite out of summer

Mosquitoes need water to breed and grow. It doesn't take much water and it doesn't take much time. So, almost anything that will hold water for a week or more can produce these pests. Check for places around your home that can cause mosquito problems. Get rid of containers that hold standing water and mosquitoes won't have a chance.
