

### 3rd dose COVID Vaccine recommended for all persons living with HIV



You have probably heard by now, but if not the CDC is now recommending that anyone living with HIV who received the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine should receive a 3rd dose.

If you received J&J at this time you do not need to get another dose.

For those who are looking for a 3rd dose, you should be able to access the 3rd dose at a pharmacy and only have to attest that you meet eligibility. You should not have to disclose that you have HIV in order to obtain the vaccine. Please spread the word and help our community get this 3rd dose.






Of the **37,968 NEW HIV DIAGNOSES** in the US and dependent areas in 2018, 17% were among people aged 50 and older.
