Objective

To provide commercial health benefit plan partners a monthly standardized update about the latest developments in Family Connects Oregon.

Status Update

- The second data reports from the data request to carriers are due to the Oregon Health Authority on Tuesday, April 30, 2024. The data reports should be submitted in accordance with the requirements outlined in the Request for Data for Family Connects Oregon Service Provision Monitoring memo sent to the carriers on December 1, 2023. If carriers have any questions or are facing any challenges with the data request, please contact us via email at oregon.uohv@odhsoha.oregon.gov.
- In accordance with the <u>rules</u>, the 2025-2027 Reimbursement Advisory Committee is gearing up! We had the kickoff planning meeting on March 21, 2024. Throughout April and May, we will be finalizing the timelines, meeting dates and recruitment details and present those at the May 2024 call. We anticipate recruitment will begin in June or July with the initial meeting in October or November.
- Malheur County Health Department began launching FCO services on April 1, 2024.
- Polk County had their kick-off meeting on February 27 and will be setting a service launch date soon.
- Oregon Health Authority is inviting 2-4 new providers to join Family Connects Oregon in 2024. The goal is for these new providers to enter the Family Connects planning phase of ~6 months in mid-2024, beginning implementation of services in 2025.
