MAJOR REVISIONS: Significant content changes made to these policies. Please review all policies with major revisions.

• <u>426 - Record Retention</u>

- Minor formatting and grammatical updates.
- Citation additions and updates.
- Added electronic record retention option for participant records and minimum requirements for electronic record retention. (Section 2.0)
 - <u>Electronic Record Checklist</u> added to the WIC Coordinator resources webpage.
- Added breast pump loan agreement, breast pump release form, and electronic record inspection forms to the retention schedule. (Appendix B)

• 452 - Civil Rights

- Minor formatting and grammatical updates.
- Citation additions and updates.
- Disability definition revision to mirror current federal and state ADA definition.
- Updated 'And Justice for All' poster requirements as part of Policy 1100 revision. (Section 1.0 and 4.0)
- Updated and clarified the State Agency Translation/Language Identification methodology for program materials. (Appendix B)

• 501 - Ordering and Securing eWIC Cards

- Removed the Appendix with the inventory log. Link to log added to policy.
- Updated card ordering process to twice a year rather than quarterly. (Section 2.0)

• <u>614 – Income Eligibility: Current Income Guidelines</u>

- Updated with 2019 Income Eligibility Guidelines.
- Effective date: 5/1/2019
- <u>660 Competent Professional Authority (CPA): Requirements</u>
 - CPA Competency Model updated with new training requirements. (Appendix A)
- 710 Breastfeeding: Definition, Promotion and Support Standards
 - Added clarification on Breastfeeding Coordinator qualifications. A minimum of 45 hours of advanced lactation training is now required within 6 months of assuming this role. (Appendix A)

• 733 – Formula Warehouse

- Removed any references to redistributing formula.
- Added procedure for handling damaged FW orders. (Section 12.0)

• 735 - Exchange and Handling of Returned Formula

- Removed procedure for handling returned formula.
- Added guidance to dispose of any returned formula and recommendations for minimizing returned formula. (Section 5.0 and 6.0)

- Effective date: 8/1/2019

• <u>769 – Assigning WIC Food Packages</u>

- An additional circumstance added when 2% milk may be issued to women and children 2 and over. (Section 8.3)
 - After the CPA completes a full diet assessment and finds the participant is at risk of inadequate intake of calcium and Vitamin D, the CPA may approve issuance of 2% milk instead of fat free and 1% if that would help to boost intake. Justification must be documented in progress notes and the need for 2% milk must be reassessed and documented at each certification.
- Added new reference NIH: Calcium and Vitamin D Important at Every Age.

• <u>820 – Quarterly Nutrition Education Contacts</u>

- Simplified follow-up processes for lesson completion in WICHealth.org (Section 4.0)
- Revised language to clarify when MOUs are needed and to use consistent term of "session guide" rather than lesson plan or outline. (Sections 6.0 and 8.0)
- Removed Appendix B and replaced it with a <u>fillable form</u> on our website.
