## **FORMS**

## Health Assessment

- Parent form K-8<sup>th</sup> grade (POR-927)
- Student (child/early adolescent) form 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade (POR-905)
- Student form (adolescent) 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade (POR-925)

# Health History

- K-8<sup>th</sup> grade (POR-914)
- 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade (POR-915)

### **EPISODES**

- On a first visit and/or return visits in which episodes have not been opened the CMA/LPN/CHN will open a new episode (School-aged Prevention Health).
- The huddle is an opportunity to review who needs an episode opened or resolved.
- The episode will be named the date that it is opened.
- The episode will be resolved either at the annual date or when the next full health assessment is reviewed.

### **IN EPIC**

- All priorities need to reviewed annually by stratifying them – this is mandatory
  - o Preventive messaging (low risk): "anticipatory guidance"
  - Problem Identification and intervention (moderate risk):
    added to "Problem List" and care staged in progress note
  - Referral and follow up (high risk): Problem List and referral initiated
- May add comments if indicated encouraged
- Only check topics that have been reviewed encouraged
- Click on the individual Strengths as you identify them verbally or when reviewing the Health Assessment form
- May review info in **Episode Report** under specific episode
- Now use <u>.sbparentcontact</u> when making parent contact
- Do not use .risk from this point on (after 11/9/12)
- **Scrubbing:** review the *Flowsheet* under "School-aged **Prevention Health**" and identify the first date all of the priorities have been entered for that episode.
