- 2003: Major budget cuts
- 2004: “Funding formula” developed

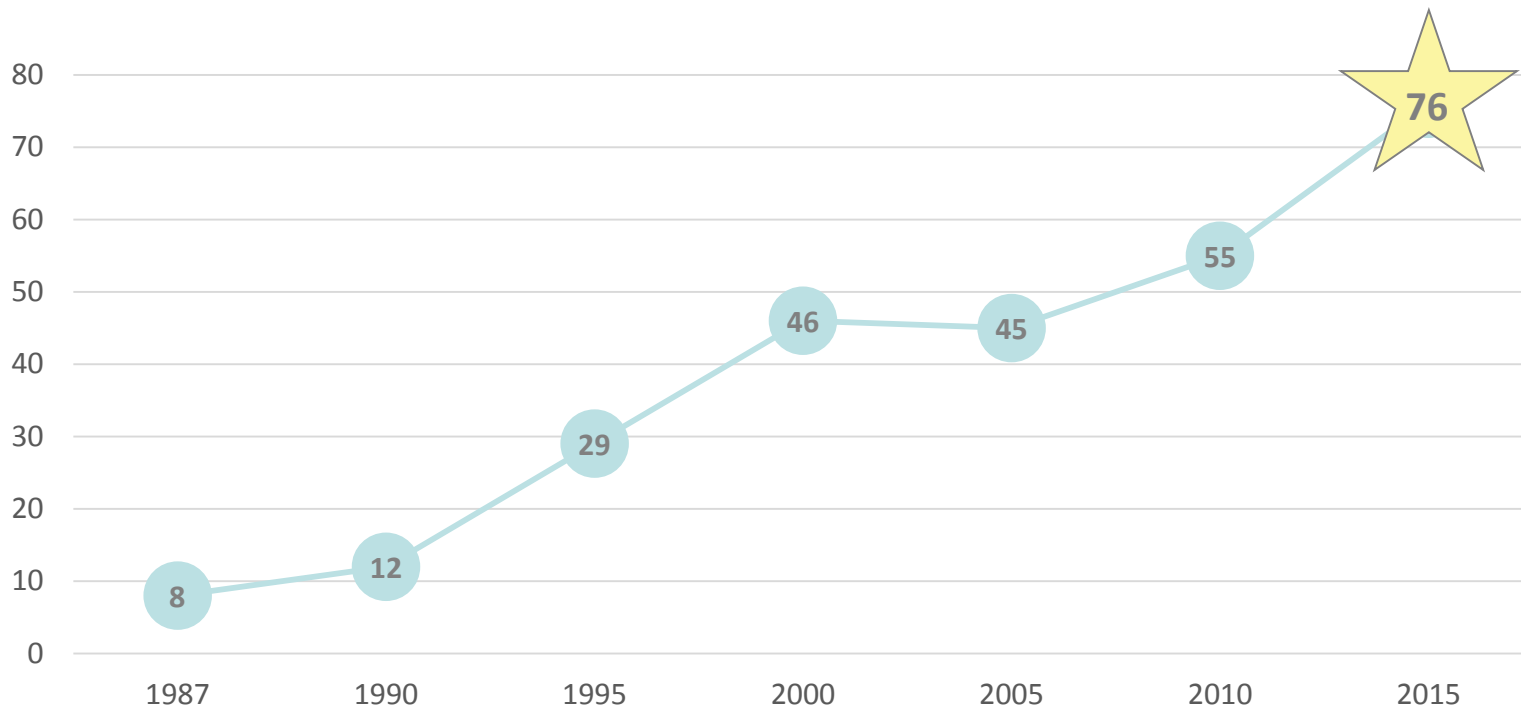


Brief history of SBHCs in Oregon...

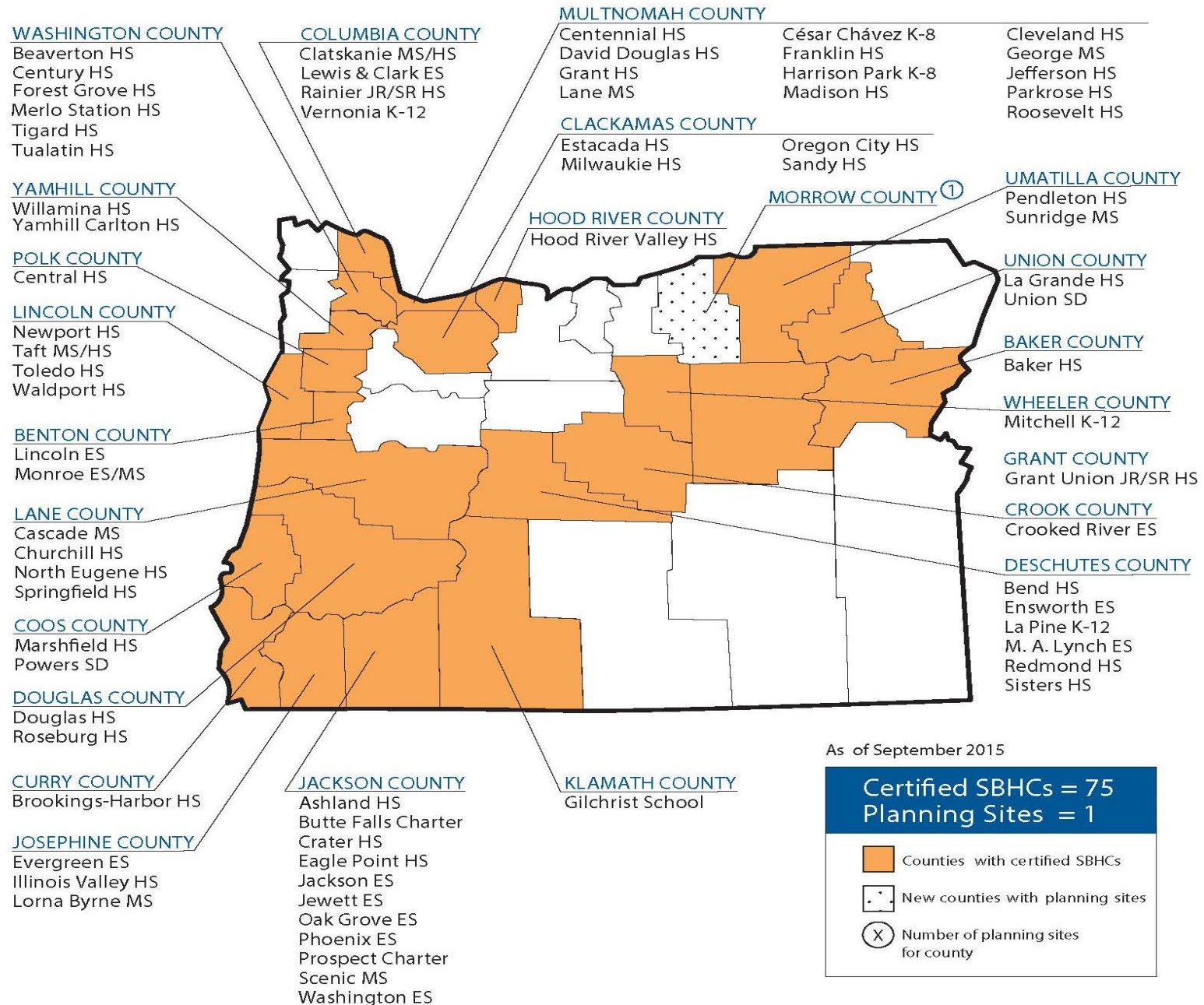
- 2004: Planning grants

Growth of Oregon SBHCs (1987-2015)



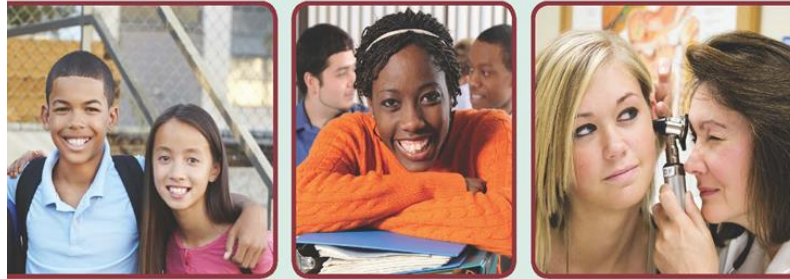

- 43% of SBHCs sponsored by LPHAs
 - 29% have FQHC status
- 51% recognized PCPCH

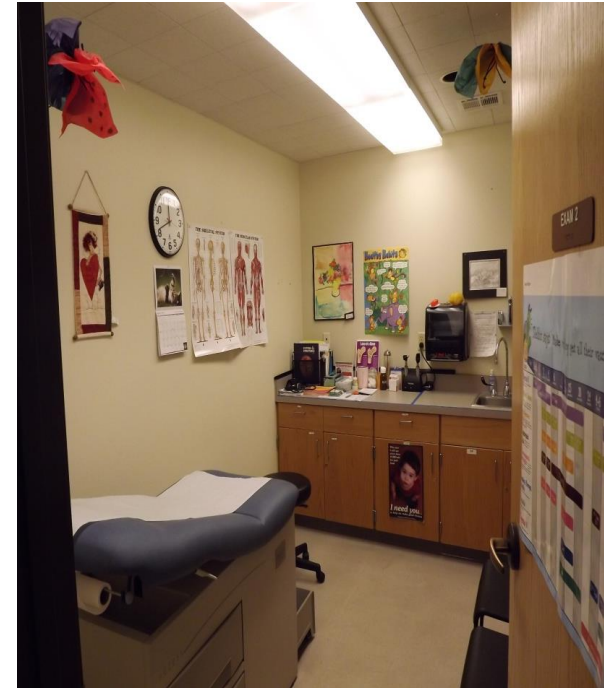

Staffing & Comprehensive Services

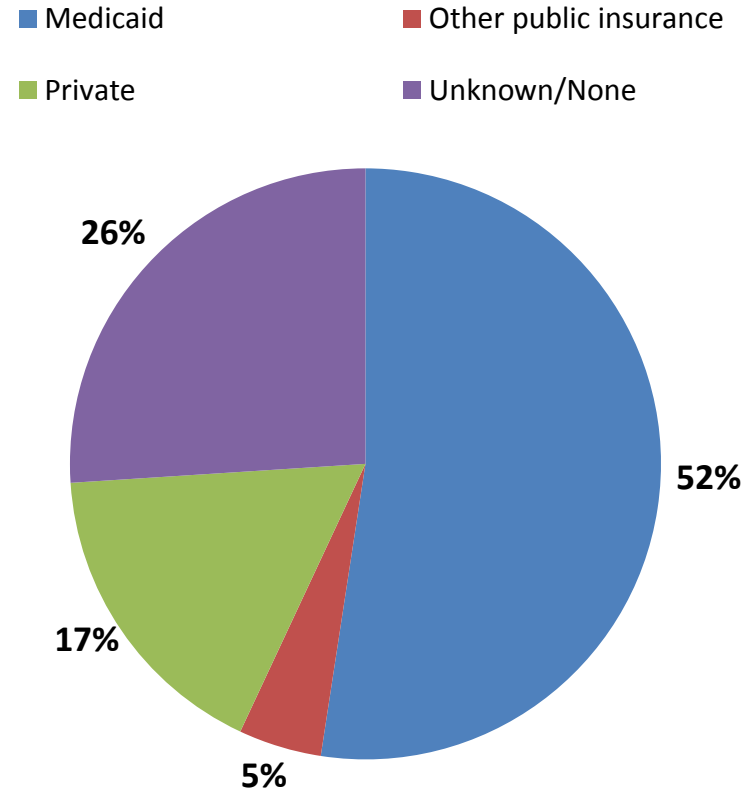
- Prevention and early intervention

SBHC Funding

- State funding:
 - To LPHAs via Program Element 44
 - Funding formula:
 - Counties with 1 certified SBHC: \$60,000/year
 - Counties with >1 certified SBHC: \$55,239/year
- Medical sponsor
- Billing revenue
- School districts
- Private grants
- Fundraising

Community Readiness

- Establish SBHC planning governance
- Convene Planning Committee
- Engage local stakeholders
- Understand the SBHC model
- Assess the need for a SBHC in your community



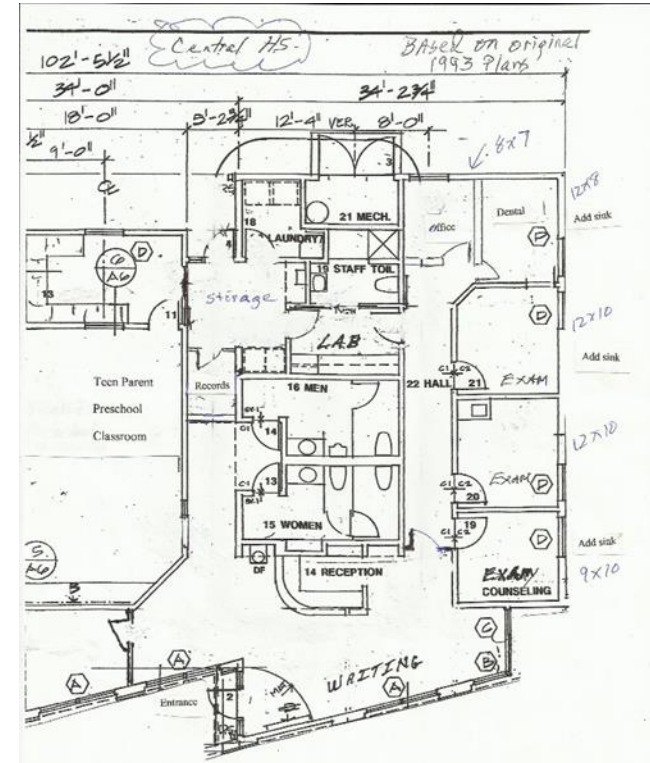
Community Readiness

- Engage and inform the community
- Engage youth and parents
- Select a well-considered location
- Identify a medical sponsor
- Develop a business plan



Implementation

- Determine clinical services and referral sources
- Determine appropriate staffing
- Develop policies that promote clinical quality
- Maximize resources for SBHC build out
- Ensure clinic space is youth-friendly



Implementation

- Ensure clinic has appropriate supplies
- Ensure data & billing capabilities in place
- Develop a marketing plan
- Engage your local CCO
- Prepare clinic to meet SPO Standards for Certification
