



Purpose of SB 738



- Encourage the development of innovative practices in oral health care delivery systems
- Focus on providing care to populations that have the highest disease rates and the least access to dental care




Oregon Faces an Access to Dental Care Problem

- Dental Insurance
 Care
- 2/3 of Oregon dentists <u>do not</u> accept Medicaid (ADA 2015)



- 33 of 36 Counties in Oregon are Dental HPSA
- 1,035,319 or 25% of Oregonians are on Medicaid (Oregon Health Plan) June 2016





Offers opportunity to safely demonstrate and evaluate new approaches to care delivery before changing laws and regulations

 SB 738 Allows an <u>unlicensed</u> person to <u>practice</u> <u>dentistry</u> or <u>dental hygiene</u> in approved pilot project





- Pilot Projects are designed to run <u>3-5 Years</u>
- Pilot Projects can apply for a modification to extend the project timeline





Program Goals

 Goal is to ultimately make recommendations for best practice approaches



• Report back to legislature at conclusion of each pilot project







- OHA Program Modeled after California Program
- California Health Workforce Pilot Project Program (HWPP)
- California HWPP began 1972



- California Program Spans all Health Professions
- Oregon Program is Limited to Dental
- Sunsets in 2025




CALIFORNIA PROGRAM STATISTICS

173 sponsors have submitted applications since 1972 123 HWPP applications have been approved 117 HWPP applications have been administered 77 Pilot Projects have resulted in legislative and/or regulatory change




California Health Workforce Pilot Projects (HWPP)

Figure 1. Map of the states where dental hygienists can administer local anesthesia.¹²










SB 738 Abbreviated Time line

- OHA does not Fund Projects





Oregon Health Authority Role

- Approve Pilot Project Applications through a process
- Monitors Pilot Projects through Progress Reports and Site Visits
 Integration of the second seco



- Monitors for Patient Safety
- Responsible for Ascertaining the Progress of the Project in meeting its Stated Objectives and in Complying with Program Statutes and Regulations

- Attendance in Dental Pilot Project Oversight & Advisory Committee
 Annual Meeting
- Advisement on the efficacies of training, competencies and the collection of data
- Review and advisement of project protocols related to the ongoing assurance of patient safety
- Participation and attendance in Site Visits. Members are requested to attend at least one Site Visit during each year of the pilot project.
- Advisement on the evaluation of project progress reports as needed
- Advisement on project issues, should they arise

- Required by Oregon Administrative Rules
- 333-010-0455 Program Responsibilities

(b) Periodic, but at least annual, site visits to project offices, locations, or both, where trainees are being prepared or utilized.





• 333-010-0455 Program Responsibilities

(a) Site visits shall include, but are not limited to:

- (A) Determination that adequate patient safeguards are being utilized;
- (B) Validation that the project is complying with the approved or amended application; and
- (C) Interviews with project participants and recipients of care.



- Developing comprehensive standardized tool for site visit process
- Report Pass or Fail based on criteria
- Report issued within 60 days of site visit
- Oversight & Advisory Committee Members integral to the process

OAR 333-010-0455 requires that Site Visits Shall Determine that Adequate Patient Safeguards are Being Utilized








- Standardized Process
- Abstraction Records

 Percentage of Records
 - Chart Audits
 - -X-Ray
 - Chart Notes
 - Treatment
 - Referral
 - Follow-Up





- Example from a <u>California HWPP Pilot Project</u>:
- Denticon ID 1339: RDHAP #11, Collaborating Dentist #13
- Patient number 31 is a 40-year old male seen in a sub-acute facility.

Evaluation Team Findings:

- RDHAP reviewed the medical history.
- Date of last dental exam was unknown.
- Radiographs were taken. Eight ITRs were placed. Placements were staying-done well.
- Procedures were successful. Dentist reviewed photos and notes.
- Referred. Patient see by Dentist on 6/8/2012.
