



## **Health Facility Licensing and Certification**

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## **Acute Hospital Care At Home**

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is approving individual requests for hospitals to provide Acute Hospital Care at Home (AHCAH) services. AHCAH services are described by CMS in a <u>press release on November 25, 2020.</u>

## **Process Steps**

To begin providing this service in Oregon the provider must already be a licensed Oregon hospital and complete the following steps:

- Submitting and receiving a temporary license for this service using the
  <u>Hospital License Temporary Space for COVID-19 Instructions and Application</u>. The application should specify the addition of an Acute
  Hospital Care At Home service. Completed license applications should be sent to <u>mailbox.hclc@state.or.us</u>. Health Facility Licensing & Certification approves temporary applications by email.
- 2. After licensure, the hospital may seek reimbursement for the AHCAH services by applying for a CMS waiver for specific Conditions of Participation related to nursing services and care. The CMS waiver process starts at the CMS Acute Hospital Care At Home Portal.

## **Expiration**

Approved temporary licenses are granted for six months and may be renewed if the COVID-19 pandemic is still impacting hospital services in the month prior to the license expiration. Waivers of Oregon Administrative Rules 333-500-0025(7) and 333-500-0010(46) expire with the temporary license.

CMS has indicated that approval of these waivers will end when the Public Health Emergency ends.

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
