


## EASA Data


- More than 1100 young people and families since 2008
- Approximately .77/10,000 population penetration
- 73% male
- 29% under 18 at intake (6-year average)
- More than 9 in 10 have active family engagement
- At discharge 59% not on disability and not planning to apply
