 - (c) If you do not protest this further commitment within 14 days, your commitment will be continued for an indefinite period of time up to 180 days.
 - (d) If you do protest a further period of commitment, you are entitled to a hearing before the court on whether your commitment shall be continued.
 - (e) You may protest either orally or in writing by signing the form accompanying this
 - (f) You are entitled to have a physician or qualified person as recommended by the Division, other than a member of the staff at the facility where you are confined, examine you and report to the court the results of his examination.
 - (g) You may subpoena witnesses and offer evidence on your own behalf at the hearing.
 - (h) If you are without funds to obtain legal counsel or examining physician or qualified person as recommended by the Division, the court shall appoint such legal counsel, physician or qualified person at no cost to you.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONTINUE COMMITMENT

The Community Mental Health Program Director for this county has requested that your commitment be continued for an additional period of time. You have a right to the following:

- (a) You may consult with legal counsel, and legal counsel will be provided for you without cost if you are unable to afford a legal counsel.
- (b) If you do not protest this further commitment within 14 days, your commitment will be continued for an indefinite period of time up to 180 days.
- (c) If you do protest a further period of commitment, you are entitled to a hearing before the court on whether your commitment shall be continued.
- (d) You may protest either orally or in writing by signing the form accompanying this
- (e) You are entitled to have a physician or qualified person as recommended by the Division, other than a member of the staff at the facility where you are confined, examine you and report to the court the results of his examination.
- (f) You may subpoena witnesses and offer evidence on your own behalf at the hearing.
- (g) If you are without funds to obtain legal counsel or examining physician or qualified person as recommended by the Division, the court shall appoint such legal counsel, physician or qualified person at no cost to you.
