- Medical Review Officer oversight
- Toxicology testing
- Interactive Voice Response (IVR) access to daily testing requirements

- Safe practice evaluations

### Organization Services

- Consultations for Oregon hospitals and medical staffs
- Coordination with Health Profession Licensing Boards
- Training on signs and symptoms of substance abuse and mental health issues
- Identifying licensees with substance abuse and mental health issues.
