**Subject:** MOTS October 2015 Changes

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October 1 is coming up soon. Health Systems, formerly MAP and AMH, wants to be sure everyone is aware of the changes set for that date. Health Systems is following the federal direction for making the change from ICD-9 to ICD-10 diagnosis codes effective October 1, 2015.

**To make the transition easier, please submit updates on clients whose Client Treatment Status changes from Active to any other status prior to October 1, 2015. On and after October 1, 2015 you must update the Behavioral Health Detail diagnosis code field to include at least one ICD-10 code and Client Entry submitters must delete the ICD-9 codes in order to submit a status change or inactivate a client. ICD-9 codes will not be accepted after October 1, 2015, so be sure all ICD-9 codes have been submitted before October 2015.**

Changing from ICD-9 to ICD-10 negates the need for the GAF or CGAS scores. The GAF field will become an optional field effective October 1, 2015. Client Entry submitters can enter the score or leave the field blank. EDI submitters can either continue sending the score or leave the file position empty. If the data element is submitted, it will be available in MOTS for reporting purposes.

Health Systems is also adding new values to the Veterans Status and Living Arrangement fields beginning October 1, 2015. These new values will be in the drop down menus for Client Entry submitters. If you submit via EDI, you must begin submitting the new values no later than January 1, 2016. This decision was made in order to give more time for updating EHRs.
