Code Table Changes in MOTS

Effective **April 1, 2016** the following changes will be made to several code tables in MOTS:

- Referred From – “Crisis Bed” will be added
- Referred To – “Crisis Bed” will be added
- Legal Status – “Involuntary Custody” will be added
- Non-Medicaid Procedure Modifier – “H9 – Jail Diversion” will be added

The biggest change will be to the Addiction Level of Care codes on the Addiction Detail tab.

- The descriptions will change from using Roman numerals to using Arabic numbers. (Example: Level II.I will become Level 2.1)
- One code will be removed (Level III-D)

- Two codes will be added (Level 3.2-WM: Clinically Managed Residential Withdrawal Management and Level 3.7-WM: Medically Monitored Inpatient Withdrawal Management)
- The D values will be changed to WM (Example: Level II-D will now be Level 2-WM)

Remember, these code table changes won't be in effect until **April 1, 2016**.

Johnny is in DUI Diversion but doesn't have a Driver's License

...How do I enter him in MOTS?

In MOTS when DUI Diversion or DUI Convicted is in the legal status field, the ODL/OR ID field is required. BUT, when the client either doesn't have a license at all or is from out of state, it is impossible to submit the behavior health record.

It is important to get the legal status correct if you have a DUI client. Even if you do not have the Oregon Driver's License, or if the client doesn't have a number, please fill out the legal status correctly.

According to the Reference Manual, if you need to have a placeholder in the ODL field please use "0000000." When the client gets their Oregon Driver's License, Oregon ID, or the DMV assigned reference number, you should update this field with the correct information.

Client Entry Bug Fixed

Earlier this month, the MOTS team did an emergency fix to Client Entry. Data on client records older than two years did not show any longer. This bug prevented closing treatment episodes for some clients who had been in the system for more than 24 months.

The bug never affected data in MOTS. It only affected how data was displayed in Client Entry for some clients. EDI providers were not affected.

The fix was completed earlier this month, and now all providers using CE can see the most recent episode data for a client no matter how old.
