Here are the answers to the quiz questions:

1. MOTS is the new data collection system replacing CPMS. **TRUE**
2. MOTS Client Entry is now ready for Providers to use to enter data. **TRUE**
3. The only way to get data into MOTS is through MOTS Client Entry. **FALSE**, there is also EDI (files sent from OWITS or a providers own EHR/EMR).
4. All providers must register in MOTS, regardless of how they are going to submit their data. **TRUE**
5. You will use the same CPMS Providers Numbers in the new MOTS system. **FALSE**, you will be using your *OR Medicaid Provider ID*.
6. Dual Diagnosis clients must be enrolled twice in the new MOTS system. **FALSE**, you only need to enter them once.
7. There is no training on how to use the new MOTS Client Entry Tool. **FALSE**, there has been and will be plenty of training opportunities.
8. If a provider wants to submit data from their own EHR, they can begin doing that today. **FALSE**, AMH is not ready yet, but you can send test files. Our goal is to have the EDI up and running within a few months.

### **Non-Medicaid Services Policy:**

As requested by many providers, the Non-Medicaid Services Policy has been updated to improve clarity of which services should be reported and when to report. The policy is located on the COMPASS web page at:

**OR Medicaid Provider Number:** A policy was recently developed regarding the use of this number for the registration/set up process within MOTS. AMH will use the OR Medicaid Provider number to uniquely identify each behavioral health entity and track performance. Providers will no longer have multiple provider numbers for various programs, as is the current structure within CPMS. Please review this document regarding limitation of using one number for all entities and the process to request a number or additional numbers.
