Consent Agenda

The Committee approved the April 18th, 2014 minutes. Note the additional G codes for the SBIRT measure that the Committee approved in April were listed incorrectly in the minutes (as G0042 and G0043) and will be corrected to G0442 and G0443.

The Committee agreed to cancel the June 20th Committee meeting and hold an in-person meeting July 18th from 9:00 am – noon. The July agenda will focus on 2013 performance and the results of the first quality pool distribution and reviewing the results of the 2015 CCO Incentive Metrics feedback survey.

Updates

Lori Coyner provided an update on the April 30, 2014 reports provided to CCOs, the final 30-day validation period, and the anticipated timeline for the 2013 quality pool distribution. The Committee requested time on a future agenda to discuss CCO performance and the range of quality pool funds earned.

Recommended Adult Dental Measures

In February, the Metrics & Scoring Committee asked the Dental Quality Metrics Workgroup to reconvene and provide additional recommended adult dental measures. Dr. Eli Schwarz presented on behalf of the Dental Quality Metrics Workgroup to recommend Any Dental Service for adults (all ages). Not only is this measure a good proxy for access to dental care, but this measure can also be stratified by many variables, including specific age groups.

The Committee agreed Any Dental Services for adults (all ages) is a good first year measure for dental care and will consider it with the full list of recommended measures under consideration for 2015.

Report on Hospital Performance Metrics Advisory Committee

Lori Coyner provided an overview of the work of the Hospital Performance Metrics Advisory Committee for the Metrics & Scoring Committee's information.

The Hospital Metrics Committee selected five areas of care and up to three measures under each area of care. Upon review, CMS asked to see more measures aligned with the CCO metrics and wanted to see hospitals working more collaboratively with CCOs. OHA will provide an update on the ongoing

Report on HB2118 (CoverOregon) Metrics Committee

Lori Coyner also provided an update on the work of the HB2118 Metrics Committee for the Metrics & Scoring Committee's information.

The HB2118 Metrics Committee was legislatively established and charged with recommending a set of core metrics that would be consistent across CCOs, PEBB/OEBB, and CoverOregon plans, with the potential to expand to commercial plans. The HB2118 Committee reviewed focus areas from CMS waiver, existing CCO measures, and existing PEBB/OEBB, and CoverOregon measures, with a focus on alignment across all measure sets.

The Committee recommendation will be presented to the legislature, but in light of other CoverOregon issues, it is unclear how the recommendation will be addressed and utilized.
