Dr. Eli Schwarz is Professor and Chair of the Department of Community Dentistry at the School of Dentistry, Oregon Health & Science University. Previously, he has held professional positions in Australia (Professor and Dean, Faculty of Dentistry, University of Sydney); in the USA (Executive Director of the American and International Associations for Dental Research (AADR/IADR)); in Hong Kong (Professor of Public Health Dentistry and Dean of Dentistry, University of Hong Kong); and in Denmark (Chief Dental Officer, National Board of Health, and Associate Professor, University of Copenhagen).

Professor Schwarz has a D.D.S and a Ph.D. from University of Copenhagen, Denmark, and an M.P.H (Cum Laude) from Hadassah Medical School, University of Jerusalem. He is a Founding Fellow of the HK Academy of medicine and a Fellow in the specialty of Community Dentistry in the HK College of Dental Surgeons. He is also a Fellow of the American College of Dentists and a Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons. In 1987, he was conferred the Royal order, Knight of the Order of Dannebrog, by Her Majesty Queen Margrethe II of Denmark.

Research interests: Oral Health Services Research, Epidemiology, and Preventive Dentistry. More than 100 articles, reports and book chapters, and more than 100 published abstracts and invited presentations.
