

2017 CCO Incentive Measure DRAFT Benchmarks

July 25, 2016

The Metrics & Scoring Committee has selected the measure set, and adopted updated benchmarks and improvement targets for 2017, reflecting improved CCO performance.

Note several measures are still pending Committee discussion. The Committee finalize remaining benchmarks, improvement targets, and challenge pool measures at their August meeting. OHA will update this document after those decisions have been made.
