2015 CHART REVIEW GUIDANCE

2015 chart review guidance will be published on July 28th online at:
www.oregon.gov/oha/analytics/Pages/CCO-Baseline-Data.aspx

Key takeaways

- OHA will provide CCOs with a preliminary and final sample.
- The chart review due date will likely be early April so that final results can be provided as part of the April 30th release.
- Chart review is required for all three measures.
- Clarification: CCOs can use administrative data to identify positive numerator events for the sample. This was allowed in 2014, but not clear for all CCOs.
- Data submission template will be provided later this fall / with the preliminary sample.

DASHBOARDS

July release (July 28th) will include

- CAHPS – 2014 baseline and 2015 improvement target.
- SBIRT (all ages) -- 2014 baseline and 2015 improvement target.
- Dental sealants – 2015 improvement target.
- Effective contraceptive use (all age breakouts) – 2014 baseline, current rolling window, 2015 improvement target
- Follow up after hospitalization for mental illness – 2014 baseline, current rolling window, 2015 improvement target.

And not in dashboard, but separate file:

- DHS custody – 2014 baseline, 2015 improvement target

August release (Aug 25th) will include

- CCO level comparison report.





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MEASURE DEVELOPMENT FOR 2016

2016 INCENTIVE MEASURE DEVELOPMENT

- OHA intends to publish 2016 incentive measure specifications in late October / early November 2015.
- Additional discussion with TAG will be needed this fall to finalize the tobacco prevalence (bundle) measure specifications, any other minor specification updates, and the health equity composite measure.*

*The Committee has expressed interest in adopting the health equity composite for the 2016 challenge pool, although this decision will not be made until their September meeting.


TOBACCO PREVALENCE (BUNDLE): UPDATED SPECIFICATIONS

Outstanding questions for specification development

- Modality and timing of cessation benefit survey.
- Minimum quantity of cessation medications for benefit floor.
- Clarification of two rates (cigarette smoking versus tobacco use) and which categories roll up into which rate.
- Population threshold for recording smoking / tobacco use.

Tobacco use prevalence improved in 10 of 16 CCOs between 2013 & 2014.

Gray dots represent 2011 baselines, which are pre-CCO and based on data from the predecessor care organization. Baseline data for PacificSource Central and Gorge are combined.



TOBACCO PREVALENCE (BUNDLE): BENCHMARK OPTIONS

Would like TAG to consider benchmark / improvement target options for recommendation to the Committee in September.

Options (suggested to date):

- 25% benchmark: goal established in 1115 demonstration waiver for Medicaid adult tobacco prevalence.
- Improvement target only (e.g., 1 percentage point improvement each year).
- Regional benchmarks, based on variations in prevalence across the state.

Will continue discussion at August TAG meeting.


Staff will bring revised draft specifications for the tobacco prevalence (bundle) to the August TAG meeting.



(2014 MEDICAID BEHAVIORAL RISK FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM SURVEY DATA)




COMMITTEE INTEREST

- Last summer, OHA fielded a survey to collect stakeholder input on current and potential CCO incentive metrics: food insecurity screening was one of the proposed potential metrics.*
- The Committee short-listed the measure for 2016, noting the importance of the topic and the need to be careful to move from process measures to upstream, social determinants of health measures.
- This summer, the Committee confirmed their interest in a food insecurity screening measure and determined measure development work was needed before any potential measures could be adopted for 2017.
