

Oregon Tobacco Quit Line Benefits

Benefits from a CCO contract fall in the first category listed, Insured Adults (with Quit Line Benefits), however, the specific services offered will depend on the contract that the CCO signs with Alere.

Insured Adults (with Quit Line Benefits)

- Transferred to their health plan specific benefits – coverage varies

Insured Adults (without Quit Line Benefits) ready to quit within 30 days or already quit:

- 1-Call + 2 weeks of NRT (patch or gum)
- Re-enrollment allowed 1/ 6 months

Uninsured Adults ready to quit within 30 days or already quit:

- Multiple Call program + 2 weeks of combination NRT (patch and gum)
- Re-enrollment allowed 1/ 6 months

Medicaid FFS Oregon Open Card (DMAP):

- Multiple Call program + 8 weeks NRT (patch or gum)
- Re-enrollment 1/12 Weeks for counseling and NRT benefit

Certain sub-populations are eligible for Quit Line benefits independent of insurance status.

HST/CAREAssist (residents who are HIV positive):

- Multiple Call program + 8 weeks NRT (patch or gum)
- Re-enrollment 1/12 months

Youth Support Program:

- Multiple Call program to youth 13-17
- Unlimited re-enrollment
- No NRT

Pregnant Women Program

- 10 Call program
- Available to Pregnant and 6 months postpartum women
- 2 weeks of combination NRT (requires a doctor's letter)
- Reenrollment 1/6 months
