





Project Scope & Timeline

Support electronic collection of Meaningful Use CQMs and CCO metrics by Spring 2015	Develop dashboards and benchmarking, expand to other populations - PEBB/OEBB, PCPCH, CPCi, and Cover Oregon	Link to claims and administrative data , incorporate into the quality infrastructure, enable innovative uses such as risk profile comparison based on clinical data

OHA Metric TAG's Role

Provide guidance to OHA throughout the design, development, and implementation of the CQMR

Prior feedback:

- Patient level vs. aggregated data
- Submitting data from CQMR back to CCOs

Proposed Key Uses/Services

- Reporting quality measure data required by multiple initiatives
- Exchanging data with other entities/programs (CCOs, other P4P programs, etc.)
- User-interface to support data analysis at population and patient levels
