

Using 834 enrollment file to determine Children entering substitute care -

MMIS

Perc Codes

- 19 Child welfare;
- GA General Assistance; not Medicaid, but same benefits and CCO coverage
- MC Medicaid expansion eligibility (ACA); code will become effective on 1/1/14

Division Codes Specify "CSD" to exclude OYA clients

Branch Codes Filter out "6050" to exclude adoption/guardian/non-foster cases

Coverage effective date options in MMIS for CCO metric

Coverage/CCO assignment can change several times in 1st 60 days

Eligibility effective date can be back-dated, in which case the information was not available to CCOs on the effective date; this date should match date the child entered foster, but doesn't always

MMIS is less reliable than OR-Kids for pinpointing the date of entry into foster care, but can pinpoint when coverage under Child Welfare begins or the date from which CCO's should be aware a child has entered foster care and has been assigned to that CCO.

The current MMIS hierarchy does not protect records of children in CW from changes by other users, resulting in some eligibility changes that are corrections for errors and don't reflect real-life changes in a child's eligibility.
