Important: Renew OHP for you and your household

It is time to renew your household's Oregon Health Plan (OHP) coverage. Once a year, we have to review your information to make sure you still qualify. If you do not renew, your coverage will end on MM/DD/YYYY. We will send you another notice before ending your coverage.

How to renew

To keep your OHP coverage, you need to fill out a full application. Please do one of the following before MM/DD/YYYY:

- **Online application.** Complete and submit an OHP application online at OregonHealthCare.gov. —OR—
- **Paper application.** Complete and return the enclosed application. —OR—
- **Call us.** You can fill out an application over the phone. Call 1-800-699-9075 or 711 (TTY) Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Wait times may be long. Our phone lines are busy during the middle of the day, and on Mondays and Tuesdays. Calling at a different time may shorten your wait.

Please include everyone in your household on your application. More than one person in your household may receive a letter asking them to renew their OHP

You can get this letter in another language, large print, or another way that is best for you. Call 1-800-699-9075 (TTY 711).

coverage. Everyone in your household can apply on the same application. This includes your spouse, children and others you claim on your taxes.

Need help filling out an application? We have trained community partners who can help you fill out an application to renew your benefits. Application help is free. Visit www.OregonHealthCare.gov to find community partners in your area.
