Re: Targeted Case Management Providers Re-enrollment

Effective: October 1, 2004

The Office of Medical Assistance Programs (OMAP) has revised administrative rules relating to the Targeted Case Management (TCM) program. This change is a result of legal requirements and will also ensure that each provider has only one provider number for TCM.

All TCM providers will need to re-enroll with OMAP in order to continue receiving payment for TCM services. Provider enrollment forms and instructions are included in this mailing. **Since this change takes effect on October 1, 2004, your provider enrollment forms should be returned as soon as possible.**
