GET MONEY BACK!

FROM YOUR TAXES

Take the credits. Get money back!

Federal Earned Income Credit

Working families and individuals with low or moderate income may qualify. The credit may be worth up to several thousand dollars. Even if you owe no tax you may get money back, because it is refundable! To get the credit, file Form 1040 or 1040A and Schedule EIC.

Oregon Working Family Child Care Credit

Are you paying for child care? You may get up to 40% of your out-of-pocket expenses refunded (depending on family size and income) even if you owe no tax! Fill out the Schedule WFC on your state tax return.

Oregon Earned Income Credit

If you qualify for the federal credit you can claim the state credit. It is 5% of the federal credit.

Federal Child Tax Credit

You may take a credit for each dependent child under age 17. You may also get money back even if you owe no taxes! Fill out IRS Form 8812 to see if you qualify.

GET YOUR TAXES DONE FREE!

You don't have to pay someone to do your taxes!

The AARP has "Tax-Aide" sites all over Oregon. When you visit a Tax-Aide site, a fully-trained volunteer will do your taxes, free of charge. At many locations you can "e-file." E-filing speeds up your refund!

When you visit an AARP Tax-Aide site please bring:

- Your social security card or current record of your valid Social Security Number

- Copies of your returns from last year.
