Subject: PDL update

Following the Health Resources Commission's review, OMAP decided **not** to include Antiplatelets and Targeted Immuno Modulators (TIM) on the Practitioner-Managed Prescription Drug Plan (PMPDP) Plan Drug List (PDL).

All of OMAP's drug reimbursements are subject to the Pharmaceutical Services Administrative Rules (OAR 410 Division121). For example, in order for OMAP to reimburse providers, all drug categories must be prescribed for conditions that are currently funded on the Prioritized List of Health Services, whether or not they appear on the PDL.
