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On July 1, 2006, OMAP implemented a new rule, OAR 410-130-0180, to reflect a federal regulation requiring inclusion of an NDC number in conjunction with HCPC codes when billing for physician-administered drugs. Electronic billers will find a field in the 837 format for the NDC number.
