## Communicating through the Internet

DHS has a dedicated Web page for NPI information at <http://www.oregon.gov/DHS/admin/hipaa/np/main.shtml>.

Among other things you'll find there, is a form to register your NPI with DMAP\*. **DMAP needs to know your provider NPI and taxonomy codes by January 15, 2007.** This applies to both electronic and paper billers. So far only about three percent of our providers have registered their numbers with us.

We have also posted a suggested taxonomy code table on this Web page. The table does not reflect all providers. We will continue to add information as it becomes available.

## Revised paper forms

As you are aware, CMS and DHS are revising forms to accommodate the new NPI and taxonomy requirements. We have created a timeline indicating when we will start accepting each type form. The complete timeline is posted on the NPI Web page above. Although the CMS 1500 and ADA 06 (dental) forms will be released in October, DHS will

not be able to process claims submitted on the revised forms until January 2, 2007. Please continue to bill with your OMAP unique numbers on the existing form versions until then, if you bill us on paper.

On and after May 23, 2007, we will require the new revised forms, and you must use both the OMAP number and NPI when billing on paper.

**Getting an NPI is free —  
not having one can be costly!**

## Changes at the federal level

Beginning on September 20, 2006, the PDF version of the NPI Application/Update Form (CMS 10114) will no longer be available for download on the CMS forms Web site, and there will not be a link to that form from the NPPES page. They want you to apply online. <https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov/NPPES/Welcome.do>.
