Message: In December 2007, DMAP will mail a postcard to all providers indicating:

DMAP temporarily adopted 410-120-0010 to ensure that clients, in all Oregon counties that are declared by the Governor of Oregon to be in the state of emergency due to flooding, receive all appropriate and necessary services during the flooding conditions in these counties.

This temporary rule will be in effect retroactively from December 2, 2007 until it expires or the Department suspends the rule, whichever comes first.
