The weekend of June 5, DHS will correct MMIS recipient eligibility history for approximately 110,000 OHP clients.

- This data fix will only affect history segments dated on or before Jan. 19, 2009. DHS does not expect this to affect current client eligibility or claims processing.
- If you have made any manual corrections to recipient eligibility data from Jan. 20, 2009, forward, those corrections will not be affected.
- DHS successfully tested the data fix the weekend of May 13 on 200 client records.

To perform the data fix, DHS will suspend real-time claim processing from 7 p.m. on Sunday, June 6 until 5 a.m. on Monday, June 7. This means point of sale claims processing will be unavailable during that time. DMAP is sending a provider announcement to pharmacies about this change (see DMAP [IM 10-071](#) for more information).
