Effective 7/18/12, InterCommunity Health Network (H226, H240, H091) will close to new enrollment in Benton, Lincoln, and Linn counties.

Accountable Behavioral Health (M025, M027) and Mid Valley Behavioral Care Network (M028) will remain open in Benton, Lincoln, and Linn counties. Enrollment in these MHOs is limited to clients not enrolled in a Coordinated Care Organization (CCO).

Effective 8/1/12, InterCommunity Health Network CCO will open to new enrollment in Benton (E080), Lincoln (E085) and Linn (E090) counties. Starting Aug. 1, newly eligible OHP clients in these counties will be enrolled in the CCO for both physical and mental health care.
