Subject: Fee-for-service BRS rate changes effective August 1 to December 31, 2013

I am writing to let you know that effective August 1, 2013, the Division of Medical Assistance Programs (DMAP) will increase reimbursement for the service portion of daily BRS rates by 4 percent.

The new service rates are shown in the table below. These new rates will apply to services provided between August 1, 2013 and December 31, 2013.

Service	Current rates	Rates effective August 1, 2013
Assessment and evaluation	\$91.02	\$94.66
Level 4 rehabilitation services	\$113.35	\$117.88
Level 5 intensive rehabilitation services	\$135.14	\$140.55

DMAP intends to adopt new Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) and new rates for the BRS program that will be effective on January 1, 2014. Interested parties are welcome to provide comment on the proposed rules once they are available through our Rule Advisory Committee or Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.

Please remember to pay the local match percentage of the service rate as listed on DMAP's [local match Web page](#). The local match percentages change on October 1 of each year.
