The Health Evidence Review Commission (HERC) has modified the 2012-2013 Prioritized List of Health Services for the Oregon Health Plan, effective **October 1, 2013**.

The changes incorporate over 6,000 technical revisions to the ICD-9-CM, CPT and HCPCS medical codes that define the services appearing on each of the 692 lines on the Prioritized List to ensure the appropriate pairings of diagnoses and treatments. Changes include:

- Coding changes to condition-treatment pairs
- Added 10 Interim Modifications affecting numerous lines
- Added 12 new guidelines
- Revised 18 Guideline Notes
- Deleted 1 guideline (Guideline Note 1 - Health and Behavior Assessment/Intervention)
- Deleted 2 coding specifications that were never implemented
