Specification Updates

On September 28th and 30th, OHA posted revised 2015 specifications and new 2016 specifications for most of the CCO incentive measures. Updates to 2015 were primarily to incorporate ICD-10 codes into the specifications; however additional revisions were made to the effective contraceptive use measure to better capture NDCs.

OHA will be transitioning the remaining state performance measures to ICD-10 and posting revised 2015 and new 2016 specifications later this fall.
