A workgroup will be starting up soon to work out the details;</li><li>▪ HSB 4107-by Rep. Davis in regard to when amends to contracts can be applied retroactively;</li></ul> |

| <p>General Updates- Lisa Bui, Sarah Bartlemann</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Opioid Prescribing Task Force has formed. There is a request for two CMO's from the CCO's to participate. Interested parties or nominees should submit their names to Lisa Bui by next week;</li> <li>▪ Sarah shared information on the waiver update. Lori Coyner is the primary contact for waiver related items.</li> </ul>  |
| <p>HERC Update- Cat Livingston</p>                 | <p>Discussed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Back pain implementations workgroup;</li> <li>▪ Draft coverage guidance: undergoing additional public comment on skin substitutions;</li> <li>▪ Metabolic and bariatric surgery- there is an obesity taskforce;</li> <li>▪ Proposed topics for coverage guidance- Dr. Livingston went through the list and shared comments on the selected topics. The CGM will be delayed a little bit;</li> <li>▪ VbBS met last week;</li> <li>▪ Autism guidelines- currently being asked if the guideline is legal in regard to children;</li> <li>▪ Guideline note 6- working with the DOJ;</li> </ul> <p>Dr. Kim Wentz brought up the discussion on EPSDT. 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| <p>Hepatitis C &amp; High Cost Pharmaceuticals- Jim Rickards</p> | <p>Dr. Rickards shared background information with key points being:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Viral infection- acute &amp; chronic;</li> <li>▪ 150 million global affected;</li> <li>▪ Approximately 11,000 are Oregon Medicaid;</li> <li>▪ Discussed the METAVIR Score;</li> <li>▪ 5 to 20% Cirrhosis, 2 to 6% annual HCC;</li> <li>▪ 2013 new Direct Acting Antivirals (DAAs);</li> <li>▪ Target Virus Replication Proteins;</li> <li>▪ Sustained Virologic Response (SVR);</li> <li>▪ Shared a CMS letter (release 172);</li> <li>▪ Discussed ALJ;</li> <li>▪ Washington State class action;</li> <li>▪ Discussed involvement of QHOC, CCO Pharmacy directors, and the P &amp; T Committee;</li> <li>▪ Updated Fee-for-Service population coverage;</li> <li>▪ High cost pharmaceuticals situational assessment;</li> <li>▪ The P &amp; T Committee is an available venue for pharmaceutical issues. Dr. Walter Hardin is the CCO contact for this committee.</li> </ul> |
