**WHAT:** Public meeting of the Tobacco Reduction Advisory Committee

**WHEN:** 1:30 – 3:30 p.m., Wednesday, April 4

**WHERE:** Portland State Office Building, Room 710, 800 NE Oregon Street, Portland. Please note, space is limited.

**WHO:** The Tobacco Reduction Advisory Committee, which is appointed by the Governor. Its members come from private organizations and state agencies dedicated to the reduction of the harmful impact of Oregonians' tobacco use.

**AGENDA:** Meeting purpose and membership; Tobacco Prevention and Education Program (TPEP) status report and budget reallocation; TPEP budget and scalable program proposals; committee recommendations; wrap-up and next steps.

**DETAILS:** The Tobacco Reduction Advisory Committee (TRAC) assists the Oregon Public Health Division in crafting, analyzing and prioritizing programs that seek to reduce tobacco use statewide. TRAC advises the Tobacco Prevention and Education Program on budget and program matters. The committee was created in 1997 by Gov. John Kitzhaber's Executive Order No. EO-97-10.
