

NOTICE

Oregon law requires a dealer occupying less than 5,000 square feet that is not in a redemption center zone to accept empty beverage containers at all hours the store is open.

The dealer may refuse to accept:

- 1. More than 50 individual empty beverage containers per person per day.**
- 2. Containers of the kind, size and brand that the store does not sell.**
- 3. Containers for beverages that were not purchased in Oregon.**
- 4. Beverage containers visibly containing or contaminated by a substance other than water, residue of the original contents or ordinary dust.**
- 5. Beverage containers that are damaged to the extent that the brand appearing on the container cannot be identified and/or the refund value (OR 5¢ or OR 10¢) cannot be seen.**
Note: Containers that have been flattened by a reverse vending machine (RVM) should not be accepted since they have already been redeemed. Cans that have been fed through an RVM will have square indentations or perforations and will be fairly symmetrically crushed. Bottles will have a crushed neck.
