

H. ATTORNEY FEES/SANCTIONS

Case: *Westfall v. Rust International*, 314 Or 553 (1992).

Abstract: A Petition for Judicial Review or Motion for Reconsideration of a workers' compensation claim is "frivolous," and an Appellate Court may impose appropriate sanctions on a claimant's lawyer for filing that petition or motion, when every argument made on appeal is one "that a reasonable lawyer would know is not warranted either by existing law or by a reasonable argument for the extension, modification, or reversal of existing law."
